Welcome to Eclectic Lyfe LLC ("Company," "we," "us," or "our"), operating out of Jefferson, Wisconsin. These Terms of Service ("Terms") govern your access to and use of our website, live and on-demand workshops, digital downloads, community groups, and related services (collectively, the "Services").
